Cabin assignments are made on a first come, first served basis. Any cancellations or changes to your registration must be made by noon on April 18, 2018 or your payment <u>will be deposited and not returned</u>. Your registration and cabin assignment cannot be given away, exchanged, cancelled or in any way changed except by direct communication with the registrar prior to Spirit of the Pines weekend. Call June S., the registrar, at 979-236-5601 to cancel or change your registration. The cost is \$105.00 when preregistered or \$110.00 on site. The last day to preregister is April 16, 2018. <u>Do not mail your registration after April 16, 2018</u>.



ACCOMMODATIONS: Sleeping accommodations are dormitory bunk-bed style. Men's and women's cabins are separate. There are no coeducational sleeping quarters. There are a total of 12 cabins for men and 10 cabins for women. Bring your own towels, personal hygiene articles, blanket, sleeping bag, pillow, swimsuit, sports items, books, rain gear, and **TEDDY BEARS**. Consider the changeable Texas weather and be sure bedding and clothing are appropriate for variable weekend weather. **PLEASE BRING A FLASHLIGHT**. The camp covers a large area. **In case of emergency, Camp Olympia's phone number is 936-594-2541.**

Directions to Camp Olympia:



Houston: From I-45 North take exit 113, which is Hwy 19. Stay on Hwy 19 about 20 miles to Trinity, turning right at the second red light onto Hwy 94. Go 3 miles and turn right on FM 3188. Follow the road about 5 miles to the gates of Camp Olympia.

Dallas: From I-45 South, exit Hwy 7 at Centerville. Go east to Crocket. In Crocket, go right on Loop 304 for about 1 mile. Turn right on Hwy 19 and travel south to Trinity. In Trinity, turn left at the first red light onto Hwy 94. Go 3 miles and turn right on FM 3188. Follow the road about 5 miles to the gates of Camp Olympia.

Beaumont: From Beaumont, take Hwy 69 North to Woodville. Take Hwy 287 northwest to Groveton. In Groveton, turn left on Hwy 94 and travel 15 miles southwest. Turn left on FM 3188. Follow the road about 5 miles to the gates of Camp Olympia.

Recreational Facilities: Ropes course, swimming and canoeing will occur on Saturday afternoon and are included in the price of registration.

Cost of Retreat: \$105.00 per adult or child for preregistered or \$110.00 on site (includes 5 meals and 2 night accommodations). Your badge is considered your meal ticket and must be worn to the dining room. Off-Site Lodging: \$30.00 registration, \$6.00 each meal. Meal tickets can be purchased during registration times. No on-site Camping or Tents are allowed at Camp Olympia. Also, Camp Olympia is a non-smoking facility. Smoking will be permitted in a limited area on the grounds.

Priority Cabin Assignment: Pre-registrants are assigned cabin space on a first come, first served basis. To receive confirmation of your registration or scholarship, send a self-addressed stamped envelope. You must send in your check or money order with your registration slip to be considered for priority cabin assignment. Note: If you do not cancel your reservation by noon on April 18, 2018, your check or money order will be deposited, not returned. Call June S., 979-236-5601, by noon April 18, 2018 and your payment will be returned or destroyed as instructed.

Selecting a Cabin: Maximum bed capacity at Camp Olympia is 464. Cabin assignment will be made on a first come, first served basis. The cabins for both men and women are fairly close to the meeting area. You may drive to the cabins to unload or load your belongings. PARKING IS ALLOWED ONLY ALONG THE ENTRANCE ROAD BY THE CHOW HALL. Women should not loiter around the Men's Cabin areas and Men should not loiter around the Women's Cabin areas.

Women's Cabins— Clusters E-H: 5-Helena, 6-Cupid, 7-Diana, 8-Pandora, 9-Venus, 10-Athena, 11-Gemini I (quiet cabin), 12-Gemini II(quiet cabin). Artemis-women's handicapped cabin.

Men's Cabins - Clusters A-D: 1-Taurus, 2-Mars, 3-Orion, 4-Atlas, 5-Apollo, 6-Mercury, 7-Vulcan, 8-Perseus, 9-Neptune, 10-Zeus, 11-Cronus, 12-Poseidon (Quiet Cabin)

Program: Registration begins at 4:00 p.m. on Friday April 20, 2018 and ends at 10:00 p.m. Registration continues on Saturday until 1:00 p.m. The first meeting is 5:30 p.m. Friday night. Dinner will be served at 6:45 p.m. Meeting schedules for the weekend will be available at the registration desk and online.

Important: Assumption of Risk Form must be signed and turned in at the time of arrival for ALL participants, chaperones, special guests, etc. Failure to do so voids the contract and cancels the group's stay. Anyone not having a form signed will not be allowed to participate. No pets will be allowed at Spirit of the Pines.
